**SPRINGBOARD** accredited certificate courses delivered by the BKA commencing at the annual BKA Summer School. The certificates are offered at two levels, HE1/NQF4 (Springboard Modules 1 & 2) and HE3/NQF7 (Springboard Module 3). Both courses lead to nationally accredited qualifications in Kodály music education through Roehampton University and involve further independent study and additional training days.

**SPRINGBOARD MODULES 1 & 2 (HE1)** introduces students to Kodály music pedagogy and principles and teaches the musical skills and concepts that are key to the Kodály approach. Personal skills in musicianship are developed and students gain an increasing understanding of how the Kodály principles are translated into practice and how the musical elements are taught sequentially. Students are taught how to select songs and games and appraise and perform them with others. Students enrolling on the HE1 Course are not expected to have prior knowledge or experience but, as the Kodály approach is based on singing, must be prepared to use their singing voices.

**SPRINGBOARD MODULE 3 (HE3)** is offered for the first time in 2010 and will deepen student understanding and appreciation of the Kodály principles and practice. Students will further develop their own musicianship and will choose to focus on the development of teaching skills related to one of two age groups: either Early Years or Key Stage 1/2. Entry to Module 3 is dependent on the successful completion of Module 1 and 2 assignments plus an assessment of the student's musicianship skills. The musicianship level required is the *BKA Elementary Musicianship* standard and students must gain at least 60% of the marks to qualify.

All Springboard courses begin with a programme of teaching over 7 days at the Summer School, followed by several interim support days. Both courses involve an extended period of personal study which includes reading certain texts, practising the skills learned on the course, reviewing progress in using what has been learnt and producing written assignments.
